

MEDIA ACCREDITATION POLICY

D-DAY HEL 2026

dated 21 May 2026

§ 1

1. These Media Regulations define the rules of presence and work of media representatives during the D-Day Hel 2026 event (hereinafter: the "Event").
2. These Media Regulations constitute an addendum to the D-Day Hel 2026 Event Regulations and apply jointly with their provisions.
3. Media representatives shall mean persons engaged in journalistic, photographic, filming, or other activities related to the recording and publication of materials from the Event.

§ 2

1. Media accreditations authorizing access to areas designated for media representatives within the Event Site are granted free of charge upon completion of the application form available at www.d-dayhel.pl. The deadline for submitting accreditation applications is 5 August 2026.
2. The Organizer may issue different types of accreditation, depending on the function performed, differing in the scope of access to Special Zones.
3. The Organizer reserves the right to refuse granting press accreditation for organizational or safety reasons, in particular:
 - 1) in the event of limiting the number of accreditations granted to a single editorial office or entity,
 - 2) due to a limited number of places designated for media representatives,
 - 3) to persons who are not media representatives or who do not cooperate with any editorial office.
4. During the D-Day Hel 2026 Event, press accreditations will be issued only upon presentation of a valid press card or a document confirming cooperation with an editorial office.
5. Accreditation is personal and non-transferable.
6. The Organizer, including the Organizer's Services, reserves the right to verify accreditation and the identity of persons exercising rights arising from accreditation.
7. Proper completion of the accreditation application form does not guarantee the granting of accreditation by the Organizer.
8. Information regarding a positive or negative decision on the accreditation application will be sent to the applicant by email to the address provided in the form.

9. The Organizer reserves the right to refuse accreditation without providing a reason, in particular for organizational or safety reasons.
10. Collection of accreditation constitutes acceptance of these Media Regulations and the Event Regulations.
11. Accreditations will be available for collection at the main office located on the 1st floor of the Municipal Sports and Entertainment Hall between 17 and 22 August 2026, from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. The Organizer does not provide duplicate accreditations in case of loss, except in particularly justified cases at the Organizer's discretion.

§ 3

1. Entry for media representatives to designated Special Zones within the Event Site is permitted on the basis of accreditation issued by the Organizer.
2. Media representatives are obliged to:
 - 1) wear their identification badge visibly at all times while on the Event Site,
 - 2) move only within areas made available by the Organizer.
3. The Organizer may designate additional areas with restricted access for media representatives.
4. It is prohibited to enter any areas other than those indicated by the Organizer and marked on the identification badge, in particular the pyrotechnic zone and the historical reenactment zone, unless the Organizer decides otherwise.
5. Media representatives are prohibited from interfering with the course of the Event or the activities of the Organizer's Services, in particular by disrupting organization, moving barriers, or issuing instructions to Participants.
6. The Organizer or authorized persons have the right to request presentation of accreditation and an identity document in order to verify the right to remain in media-designated zones.
7. Audio and video recording shall be conducted in a manner ensuring safety and not disrupting the course of the Event or the work of the Organizer's Services.
8. Recording and publication of materials shall comply with applicable law, in particular GDPR and press law.
9. Materials may be used for informational, editorial, and promotional activities of the media.

§ 4

1. The Organizer may require media representatives to attend an organizational or safety briefing prior to the commencement of selected parts of the Event.

2. Media representatives are obliged to comply with instructions, announcements, and guidelines issued by the Organizer and the Organizer's Services.
3. The Organizer has the right to temporarily restrict or change areas accessible to media representatives for safety or organizational reasons.
4. In the event of an evacuation or any situation posing a threat to life or health, media representatives are obliged to immediately comply with instructions of the Organizer's Services and leave the designated areas.
5. In the event of any discrepancy between instructions of the Organizer and these Regulations, in situations involving a threat to life, health, or safety, instructions of the Organizer's Services shall prevail.

§ 5

1. The Organizer reserves the right to withdraw accreditation in the event of:
 - 1) violation of these Media Regulations or the Event Regulations,
 - 2) actions endangering the safety of participants,
 - 3) failure to comply with the Organizer's instructions.
2. The decision to withdraw accreditation is final and does not require justification, subject to applicable law.
3. Withdrawal of accreditation results in the obligation to immediately leave the Event Site.
4. In urgent cases, particularly related to safety, the Organizer's Services may order immediate departure from designated zones by a media representative, regardless of the accreditation withdrawal procedure.
5. The Organizer shall not be liable for the way materials are used by media after publication.
6. In matters not regulated by these Media Regulations, the D-Day Hel 2026 Event Regulations and applicable Polish law shall apply.
7. The Organizer reserves the right to amend these Media Regulations in justified cases.
